

Section 2 – Accounting Statements 2017/18 for Healeyfield Parish Council

Box 3 – in 2017/18 a grant was received from the local County Councillor to pay for the majority of the work and installation (£3500) of a lead miner statue and tub for the village. A payment was received from the Transparency Fund (£412) to help with the maintenance and running costs of the website. It was reclaimed for 2015-16 (£363).

Box 6 – payment for the installation of the lead miner statue (£400); payment for a combination locked defibrillator cabinet (£519); payment to the Faculty (£251) for changes around the war memorial; increased training councillor/clerk training costs (£208); payment for the clean-up and planting of area beside Consett Road (£294).

Box 9 – the new lead miner statue and tub have been added to the asset register (£4000)
